We are extremely excited to announce NCAD's summer performance! Join us as we present a fun and engaging journey through time with:
"Dancing Through the Decades"

This invaluable opportunity will allow each dancer to gain the experience and self-confidence that comes from performing on stage, while giving friends and family the chance to see just how much your child has learned.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Every class at NCAD will perform a dance in the show (i.e. if your child is taking 3 dance classes a week, he/she will be in 3 different dances). The dances will be rehearsed in class; no extra rehearsals required besides the dress rehearsals. (Pilates, legs and leaps, turns classes, pas de deux and pointe/variations classes are non-performing classes.)

New: Shows will be limited to 2.5 hours each

PERFORMANCE FEE:

\$100.00 first child with a volunteer during show week

\$200.00 first child without a volunteer during show week

\$60.00 each additional child

NEW! Early Bird \$25 OFF the above prices January 5-17.

Late Registration Fee: \$125 with a volunteer, \$225 without a volunteer after January 31.

Feb 1-Feb 28: registration dependent on costume availability

The performance fee covers a Dancing Through the Decades T-shirt, a performance video & stage photos, a portion of the theater rental costs, backstage & front of house staff

COSTUME FEE: Costumes will be charged per class, \$60-\$85

VOLUNTEERS: Volunteer roles include room parents, costume helpers, lobby volunteers, load in/load out, spotlight, etc... A volunteer Google doc will be sent out closer to the show.

NEW: Since dancers who provide a volunteer are given a discount, any volunteers who are unable to fulfill their commitment will be charged a \$125 cancellation fee.

- The initial performance fee is due when you register. **Deadline: January 31.** All other costume fees will be charged as they are ordered- starting Feb 7.
- These costumes are yours to keep, not rentals. (They make great Halloween costumes!)
- Some ballet classes will share costumes/roles and therefore may only have one costume fee.
- This fee does not include shoes and tights. Each dancer will need to get their own. A shoes/tights list will be released after costumes are ordered.
- All beginning dance classes, preschool combo classes and level 1 classes will only perform in 1 show. All classes level 2 and up will perform in 2 shows. We will inform you of which show(s) your child's class is performing in before tickets go on sale.
- Our performance will be split into 3 casts with older classes performing in 2 shows each. Blue cast is Friday June 26th at 1:00 and 6:00, Red Cast is Saturday the 27th at 1:00 and 6:00, Gold Cast is Sunday June 28th at 1:00 and 6:00.
- **Absence policy:** absences may affect your child's placement in the performance, as they must be able to rehearse the choreography regularly with their peers for the dance to be successful onstage. Therefore we ask that if you are planning a summer trip that you put it after the performance. If your child is sick, please let us know by email and make sure they practice their dance at home when able so that they are not too behind when they come back. If your dancer is removed from the show due to low attendance, no refunds can be given. The studio will be closed for a few weeks after the performance, with the possible exception of intensives/dance camps.
- **Costumes are purchased based on your child's online enrollment in dance classes,** so please double check that your child's enrollment is accurate in our online system or your child may not get the correct costume!

REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS SATURDAY JANUARY 31ST

HOW TO SIGN UP: You can register for the recital online! It is listed as an “event”

1. Sign in to your account through our website.
2. Click on “Classes and Events” in the top right corner.
3. Click on “Find events”. “Dancing Through the Decades” will be listed below (the event is listed in BNSL, but is for BOTH locations.) Click on that and the rest is easy: just follow the prompts and answer the questions!

***There will be no refunds once costumes are ordered.**

MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSALS:

These rehearsals will be in full costume, with hair and make-up done.

at the Bob Burton Theater, Fallbrook High School

Your child's class will be assigned a more specific date/time closer to the performance. For now please block out all of Monday June 22nd- Sunday June 28th on your calendar.
